SUPERVISORY CONSULTATION

The role of the EIOD is to authorize an appropriate service plan for the child and family.

- The EIOD may consult with a supervisor at any time during the IFSP process but may authorize up to seven units of service per week without consultation.
- The EIOD must consult a supervisor whenever authorization of more than seven units of service per week (not including service coordination, transportation, respite, assistive technology devices/services, and family/caregiver support group) is being considered during an initial IFSP meeting as well as for subsequent IFSP reviews and amendments.
